

STEAM LOCOMOTIVE 34072 257 SQN – RECOMMISSIONING CEREMONY 30TH SEPTEMBER 2017

Southern Locomotives Ltd is a not-for-profit company which restores steam locomotives. Among our seven locos are three from the Southern Railway's Battle of Britain class, built in the mid 1940's. They are 34053 *Sir Keith Park*, 34070 *Manston*, and 34072 *257 Squadron*. *Sir Keith Park* operates on the Severn Valley Railway, *Manston* is at Swanage, and *257 Squadron* will shortly return to service after an extended overhaul. To mark this event we are arranging a recommissioning ceremony to be held at the Swanage Railway on Saturday 30th September 2017.

For those who are interested, these locos have a resonance among those who served with the Royal Air Force, and their families and participation of the Poole Branch has been enlisted along with the Wareham Air Cadets. Southern Locomotives Ltd also welcome the attendance of anyone who served with 257 Squadron or has a particular interest in the squadron or the eponymous locomotive. The event will include a special train hauled by the loco leaving Swanage at around 14:00 to Corfe Castle, where a short ceremony will be held. The train will then return to Swanage, arriving around 16:00. We hope the naming ceremony will be performed by Patron, the actor Edward Fox, well known for his role in the 1969 film "Battle of Britain".
